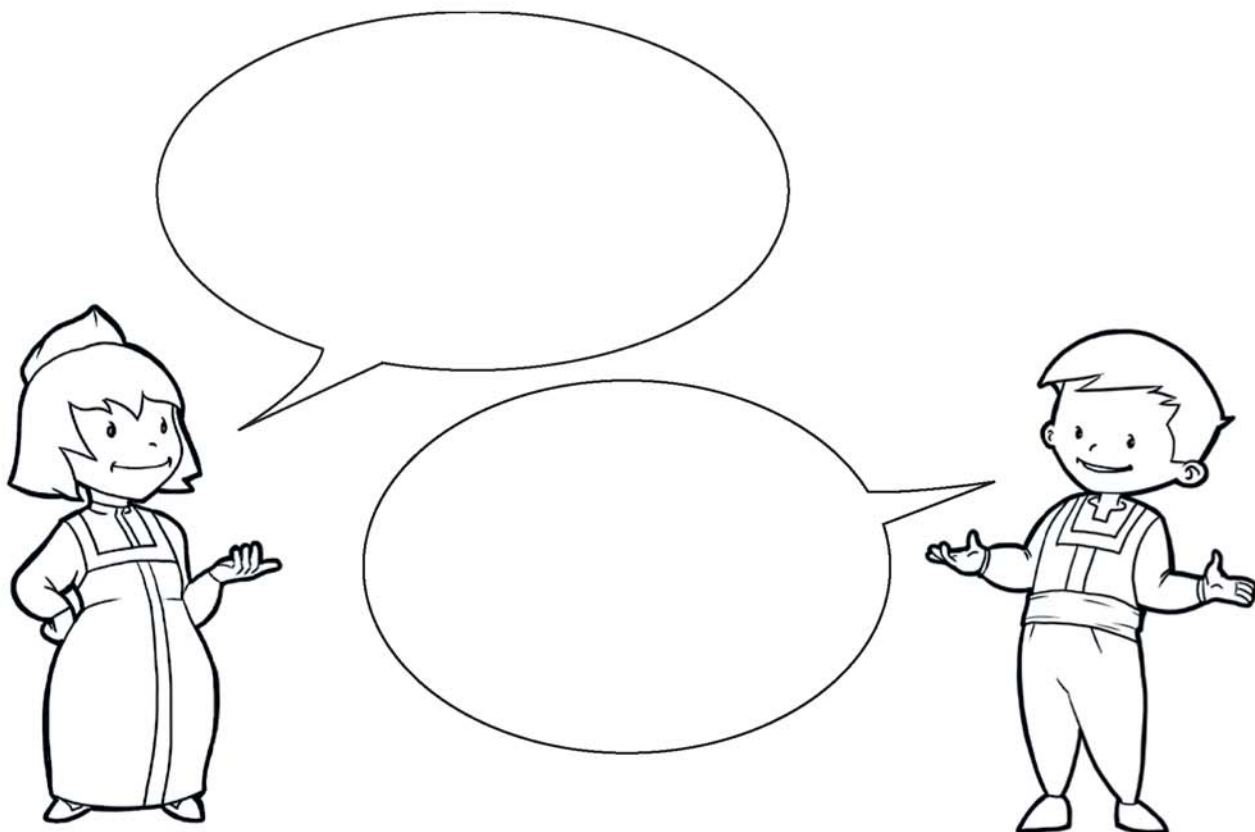


Learn How to Use the Bible

The apostle Paul was one of the most famous Christian preachers. What helped him to be fearless and share his beliefs with others?

Paul wrote: "Do your utmost to present yourself approved to God, a workman with nothing to be ashamed of, handling *the word of the truth* aright." (2 Timothy 2:15) Just as Paul used "the word of the truth," you can use the Bible to share your beliefs with others.

As a family, browse through "Bible Questions Answered," featured on jw.org. (Look under BIBLE TEACHINGS > BIBLE QUESTIONS ANSWERED.) Under the section "Prayer," select the question that you are most likely to be asked. Read the answer. Discuss which scripture each of you would read to answer the question. Then, rehearse your replies by taking turns asking the question and using the Bible to reply. In the speech bubble above the head of one child depicted on this page, write the question you might be asked. In the other bubble, write the Bible book, chapter, and verse of the scripture you would use to answer the question.
