Next, read the Illustrated Bible Story (either online or from a printed PDF), and discuss the questions that appear at the end of the story.

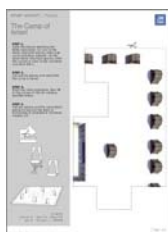

## MORE ACTIVITIES TO PRINT



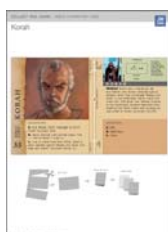
### PICTURE ACTIVITY

**COLORING PAGE** Read Exodus 28:15-21. Then, help your children to color the precious stones on the breastpiece. Finally, help them to cut out the breastpiece and to put it on.



### STUDY ACTIVITY

**PUZZLE** Have a younger child cut out and assemble the Israelite camp. Then, have him cut out the Bible characters. Ask him to write his name and draw his picture on the other character piece. Finally, have your children use the pieces and the completed puzzle to reenact the story of Korah. At each scene, ask your child: "If you were there, where would you have stood?"



### COLLECT AND LEARN

**BIBLE CHARACTER CARD** Read the profile. Ask the questions on the card. Using this card and the other cards available on [jw.org](http://jw.org), help your child find five other Bible characters who belonged to the tribe of Levi: (1) a prophet who began serving at the tabernacle as a young boy, (2) three children of Amram, and (3) a priest's son who wrote four Bible books.—**CLUES:** Read 1 Samuel 3:1; 1 Chronicles 6:1-3, 33, 34; Jeremiah 1:1.
