

With Few Weapons, David Acts Courageously


Do you remember the Bible characters who appear in 1 Samuel chapter 17? See if you can match the characters to the objects described in the clues.

STEP 1.

Cut out all the cards, and lay them facedown in rows.

STEP 2.

Turn over any two cards. If you have a character card and an object card that match, keep the two cards. If they don't match, turn them back over and try again.





STEP 3.



ARMOR





of abandoning these.


